#### Zone Co-Ordinator:

As the 2017/2018 season concludes I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the Centres of the Mid South Coast Zone for another wonderful season of Little Athletics.

The Grand Prix series was well supported this season with approximately two hundred and seventy seven (277) athletes from the six (6) member Centres within the Zone contesting the various events. This was up from the previous season with 242 athletes. Congratulations to the winning Centre, Albion Park. Those Centres that held Carnivals and supported the Grand Prix are to be commended for a job well done.

The Mid South Coast Zone Championships were hosted by the Lake Illawarra Centre at Myimbarr Community Park and were held on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10th of December 2017.

Two Hundred & Eighty three (283) athletes competed at the Championships. This was up from 262 on previous season.

The Championships commenced with a very keenly contested March Past, which was won by the St Georges Basin Centre.

My sincere thanks go to all the Officials, Centre Committee members, Computer Operators and parents who assisted at the Carnival. Everybody did a magnificent job.

Congratulations to the Albion Park Centre who took out the "Dean Blair Trophy" for an unprecedented tenth (10th) successive year.

My sincere thanks go to everybody that assisted in any capacity at the Region 4 Championships in Wollongong. The Team Managers deserve a special mention for their efforts and co-operation during the course of the weekend.

Next season Zone Carnival will be hosting by St Georges Basin on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> December 2018.

Next season the Western Riverina Zone will be hosting the Region 4 Championships at Griffith.

All Centres have now conducted their AGM's as required; I haven't received any information back from any of the clubs about their AGM & Committee.

I'd like to take this opportunity to congratulate Centre delegates for the Professional manner in which you have conducted yourselves at Zone meetings. It has been a pleasure to work with you all this season. The camaraderie within the Zone continues to flourish and I'm particularly proud of the fact that many of you still enjoy attending these meetings.

#### Albion Park:

This season APLAC had 163 registered athletes, a huge decline in numbers from the previous seasons 252. The younger age groups continue to grow whereas the seniors have dropped. Hopefully this coming season we can lift our numbers again.

Although our numbers were reduced our athletes still achieved very strong results at all levels of competition.

With the help of a dedicated committee working hard to ensure the grounds were maintained and the canteen was open APLAC hosted 17 school carnivals in 2017.

A highlight for our club in the 2017/18 season was a \$10000 grant from MP Stephen Jones. This grant assisted our club in purchasing new bigger high jump mats.

APLAC is looking forward to a bigger and more successful 2018/19 season with lots of new committee members.

#### Kiama:

The Centre had 201 registrations this season. As has been the case in previous seasons numbers were higher in the younger Age Groups. Our season concluded with the Presentation in early April.

During the installation of an Optus pole at the Kiama Sports Complex a socket was removed from the ground adjacent to our northern discus pad. This socket was one of five used to support steel poles which in turn held a net in place around the discus pad during competition. Given an electrical supply now runs through the location where the socket was it is doubtful that it can be replaced. Consequently, the ability to use this discus pad for competition is now in doubt. We have asked Council to consider options for rectifying this situation. It may be prudent to consider relocating this discus pad and erecting a permanent cage.

#### Lake Illawarra:

The Centre had 201 registrations this season. As has been the case in previous seasons numbers were higher in the younger Age Groups. Our season concluded with the Presentation in early April.

Like many other clubs, we have struggled with volunteers at committee level. This has led to our stable committee being overburdened, and really exhausted at the end of the season.

Our AGM was not very well attended, and at this stage, we have no President.

All other committee positions have been filled, with Kate Daniel being the current Vice President, and care taking the clubs responsibilities until such time that a president can be found.

We will look to transition to a new uniform over the winter period and will allow a season of both uniforms to be worn, as per LANSW guidelines.
