Albion Park Carnival

My congratulations go to the Albion Park Centre for the manner in which their Carnival was conducted in late October. Once again it was pleasing to see a number of athletes from metropolitan Centres in attendance. The opportunity was also taken to complete several officials' practicals on the day.

Dragon Derby

The St Georges Basin Centre is to be commended for the success of the "Pinkletics" themed Dragon Derby earlier this month. It was pleasing to see a very healthy attendance at this Carnival. The opportunity was also taken to complete several officials' practicals on the day.

Carnival Progression

Due to the change in Region structure this season I thought it may be prudent to review the new Carnival progression process for our Zone and Region.

All athletes at the Zone Championships will receive certificates. The first three (3) place getters in the Under 7 events will receive State medals. The first three (3) place getters in all other age groups will receive Zone medals. Only the Under 7 medals will be presented at the Zone Championships. The remaining medals and certificates will be distributed to Centres after the Carnival.

At the Zone Championships the first three (3) place getters in all Under 8 to Under 17 finals

will progress to the Region 4 Championships at Jubilee Park, Wagga Wagga on Saturday 16th and Sunday 17th February 2013. In addition the next best four (4) performances in each event across Region 4 will also qualify for the Region 4 Championships. In Relay events the first two (2) place getters will progress to the Region 4 Championships.

Should an athlete, for any reason, be unable to attend the Region 4 Championships, the Information Officer should be informed immediately. This will be the only opportunity for replacements to be considered. No further withdrawals/replacements will be accepted/designated after the completion of the Zone Championships.

At the Region 4 Championships the first two (2) place getters in all Under 9 to Under 17 finals will progress to the State Track And Field Championships at Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre, Homebush on Friday 22nd, Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th March 2013. In addition the next best eight (8) performances in each event across all Regions will also qualify for the State Track And Field Championships.

Please note that these details will be included in the Zone Championships Program.

Delegate Reports

Albion Park

No report submitted.

Kiama

Registration numbers have climbed to 344, including 50 Tiny Tot boys.

We have only lost one day this season to wet weather, although two nights have been held in wet conditions with the majority of athletes soldiering on. The ground is in excellent condition.

We have 47 athletes entered for the Zone championships, more than 50 per cent more than last year. This follows on from the Dragon Derby where about 25 Kiama athletes took part, compared with just a handful in 2011.

Lake Illawarra

Currently we have 345 registrations.

We had our "Pinkletics" night on Friday 23rd November. A great night was had by all.

October Carnival results are now online.

We have 68 entries for Zone.

Summer Carnival entries will be available at the end of November.

Milton Ulladulla

We have had a wonderful start to our season. Registrations are up to 92 with 2 more pending and a couple still trialling. Age groups range from TT to 15 in the girls and TT to 12 in the boys. The groups are evenly matched in numbers, but we have more registered boys than girls.

We have implemented the online recording system that was offered at the AGM and has been well received by those who have looked at their own results so far.

Our Coach Wensley Carter has made a huge difference to our weekly programme, most weeks we have introduced new events (or events that have not been done at MU for some years) – the triple jump, the javelin, relay training, walk events. Wensley has also put up 'How to do it' boards at each event site which the parents all appreciate. We had a parent group go round for some basic event instruction which was lots of fun as well as informative for those who took part.

We have 21 children going to Zone this year.

Shoalhaven

We have 55 athletes entered in Zone, down on last year, but with the new faces in the club it's probably to be expected. The Centre had 2 teams compete at State Relays – Under 9 Girls and Under 17 Girls. Both teams performed well and the younger girls came away with a good insight into bigger carnivals.

We have taken more registrations over the last few weeks and our numbers are around 280. Top dressing and repairs to the ground have come up very well with the bottom end low spot being repaired and the track level again. We are looking forward to the Christmas break and getting back in the New Year.

St Georges Basin

All is in readiness for the Zone Championships.

Council has approved overflow parking across the road from Sanctuary Point Oval assuming wet weather does not intervene.

General Business

1. Hurdles – Zone Championships

After reviewing Zone entries it was ascertained the St Georges Basin Centre has an adequate number of hurdles and it will not be necessary to transport extra hurdles to Zone.

2. Carnival Flyers – Inclusion In Zone Program

The Shoalhaven Centre requested that their Gala Day flyer be included in the Zone program. It was agreed that should this flyer be inserted then Lake Illawarra's Summer Carnival flyer should also be included.
