Championships – Decisions From Conference

That in the 800m event at the State Championships, the qualifiers who progress to the final be the first six (6) placegetters in each heat, plus the next four (4) fastest times, to comprise a final of sixteen (16) athletes.

ii. State Relays – Centre Categories (U17)

Rules Of Competition, Section D, Competitions, State Relay Championships, Item 2.2, Section iv to be deleted.

This section reads "Regardless of registration exclusions in i, ii or iii, all Centres are permitted to enter in the U17 teams in section 1 or 2, plus 3 and 4."
