#### • Jetstar Sponsorship and Patches

Whilst Jetstar will remain a major national sponsor they will not have naming rights from the coming season and therefore there will be no requirement for Jetstar patches to be worn on centre uniforms. At this stage, no replacement patch sponsor has been confirmed, however there is a

chance that this may still occur prior to the start of the 2017/2018 season. Asics is also no longer a sponsor of Little Athletics.

#### 2017 Annual General Meeting & Conference

A couple of different venues have been considered to replace the originally chosen venues at Sydney Olympic Park, following the announcement that an Arsenal v Sydney FC football match was now taking place at ANZ Stadium on 15 July.

The Revesby Workers Club has offered to be an event partner and will waive all room hire charges as a form of contra sponsorship. We hope to sign off on Revesby Workers Club as the 2017 Conference venue early next week. Thank you to Christine from our Revesby Workers LAC for assisting to secure this partnership.

The costs for various packages will be determined once the other major costs (i.e. catering and presenter fees) have been confirmed.

#### **Centre Constitutions**

The Following centres St Georges Basin & Milton Ulladulla have not sent in the updated Constitutions, Russell Briggs (Business Assurance) has put this in as a matter of urgency as this has now been 3 years since they have asked for all centres to update their Constitution, Russell said that the outcome for centres that do not send in the Constitution would be discussed at Board level & could be in jeopardy of losing their Centres Affiliation.

#### **Technology Update**

If you are not using the Timing Solutions system at your centre then you will not receive the \$5 rebate per registered Athlete in the upcoming season.

There will be no paper Registration and this will be replaced by Compulsory On-Line Registration in the 2018/2019 season, which will be run by Sports TG.

Meet Manger must be used for Zone Carnivals.

#### Age Change

Age Group Date Change will take effect in the 2018/2019 season, the structure will be finalized at the Board meeting in July.

#### **Regional Championships**

Regional Allowance increased to \$3000.00

Each Regional will receive brand new set of equipment that must be stored by the region and used at each regional Carnival and must be calibrated by the region each year.

#### **Dates for Zone, Regional & State Championships**

#### **Sequential registration numbers**

A discussion regarding sequential registration numbers took place on the Sunday and the outcome of this discussion was agreed by all Zone Coordinators in attendance, that Little Athletics NSW will provide centres with sequential numbers for the 2017/2018 season. This change will help officials identify an athlete with ease, as the athlete will have a unique number. We understand that some centres in the past have given their club captains registration number 1 or 2 etc. and unfortunately this will not be possible this coming season. Liverpool City Little Athletics have overcome this tradition by designing a club patch that is given to their captains (similar to our sponsor patches) which is a great idea and unique to the centre.

Please advise centres that there will be no Number 1 patch this season.

#### **Introduction to Coaching Courses**
