Kiama's first Registration Day will be held this Friday 25th August and we have another scheduled for Friday 1st September. We have put our season start back a week to Saturday 16th of September. This was done to assist the Kiama Quarriers Football Club who have made a submission to Football South Coast to host the Women's Grand Finals at Kiama Sports Complex on Sunday 10th September. This scheduling change separates the end of the football season from the start of the Little Athletics season allowing adequate time to prepare the track. Unfortunately, after making this decision, Football South Coast awarded the Finals to Wests Illawarra at Unanderra Park. This is but one of the challenging aspects associated with a shared facility. We will be running on Saturday mornings until Daylight Saving commences. The Centre will move to Friday afternoons as of 20th October.
