#### **Albion Park:**

#### **Kiama:**

- The Kiama Centre currently has 201 athletes registered.
- We have been back in action for two weeks following the Christmas-New Year break. Numbers in attendance have been quite low as the holidays continue.
- The Centre had some good results at Zone Championships in December and thus Kiama has had 36 athletes qualify for the Region 4 Championships at Wollongong in February.
- The Centre is very proud to announce that our coach, Don Hodgekiss, has been selected as a Baton Bearer in the Queen's Baton Relay for the Gold Coast 2018 XXI Commonwealth Games. Don has been coaching Little Athletes for more than 40 years and is thoroughly deserving of this honour. The Relay is coming to Kiama on Monday 5th February. Kiama is one of only four (4) communities on the Queen's Baton's route from Sydney to Melbourne selected by the Commonwealth Games Corporation.
- The Baton Relay will begin at Kiama Leisure Centre at 12.58pm and Don will be the first Baton Bearer. The baton will then pass into the hands of fifteen (15) Baton Bearers who will each carry the baton along the route down Terralong Street and into Kiama Showground.
- We hope that many of our athletes and families will be out in force to cheer for Don.

#### **Lake Illawarra:**

- We had 320 Athletes entered from 45 Centres, with athletes from as far as West Wylong, Tumit and Cessnock competing with a host of club from greater sydney and also our local athletes.
- During the day we had 14 Athletes enter their name into our carnival records, some setting new records other tying with previous records, congratulations to all those athletes.
- Enquirers coming in from school and district re timing gates and already school carnivals have been booked in.
- Have been asked by council re zone equipment we need it taken back ASAP
- Received grant for replacement of 2nd long jump so now both long jumps will be synthetic surfaces during the winter.

**Milton:**

- Competition resumes tomorrow night.
- We have 16 athletes attending Regionals.
- The track is growing well.
- Currently have a number of athletes attending ANSW events in preparation for Regionals.

**Shoalhaven:**

- 60 Athletes will be attending Regionals.
- The track is continuing to improve after the installation of irrigation system.
- We start our Age Championships tomorrow night.
- We have been through the process of selecting a new uniform design by consulting with our athletes. Implementation of the new uniform will start next season.
- Next week we will hold a “crazy hair and sock” night as a fundraiser for one of our families.
