3. Delegate Reports

Albion Park

APLAC had a fantastic 2018/19 season. This season saw our registration numbers increase, new committee members join and APLAC achieving some great things on and off the track.

Albion Park sent 20 athletes to State at Homebush with some great results achieved. The children did extremely well to compete in torrential downpours with some jumps cancelled on Sunday. In total we brought home 17 medals. 2 of our athletes Chelsea Ezeoke and Tayissa Buchanan have also been selected in the NSW team to compete at the Little Athletics Australian Championships in Hobart at the end of April.

We also sent 12 athletes to Dubbo for the state multi, our biggest team in many years for the event.

We are actively promoting next year's event in Tamworth and hope to take a team of 20+ for a fun weekend away.

Our 2 new discus cages have been installed and look great. Big thanks to Shellharbour City Council for these. This will improve the safety and efficiency of our club and school carnivals. SCC is also installing a new irrigation system in April which will see our track closed for a period of time for training. Council will also topsoil the track and assist in the remarking of our track. We have built a fantastic relationship with SCC this season and hope to see that continue with some plans in the pipework for the upgrading of our amenities block.

APLAC was successful in obtaining a \$5000 Coles Grant which went towards Electronic Timing Gates and starter. These have been delivered on Friday and we look forward to getting them up and running for some school carnivals prior to our season commencing.

To wrap up, our club presentation is this season at Kembla Joggers. A big thankyou to KJs for allowing us the use of their facilities for the evening. Our AGM is set for May 14th.
