Euro Coast Athletics would like to say a special thank you to all the clubs who wished our club well via Facebook comments and messages and also a thanks to Doonan McLaren for reaching out yesterday offering us hurdles that they don't need anymore.

Due to fire activity in late November and December we had to cancel our normal Thursday night competitions and we also had road closures leading into and out of Batemans Bay that hindered the travel of some of our volunteers and athletes.

We have unfortunately had damage re the fires and loss of equipment.

We are not able to have our competition nights since New Year's as the grounds including the running track and structures at St Peter's Broulee have been damaged.

We have also had our President lose her business building in Batemans Bay and our Registrar has lost her home in Malua Bay. We had club items stored in both of these locations and these items have been destroyed. Such as laptops, printers, gazebo's and uniforms.

The Club is currently working on one of the many Grants that have been made available to assist sporting groups to replace damaged items.

We are keen to re-commence as soon as we get the all clear from St Peter's and bring some normality back to the families in our club.

I have attached a few pictures and you can see that the fire went to the back of the container (scorching the inside back wall) and the field has been blackened.

A bit of rain this afternoon should bring it back to green!

The Kiama Centre currently has 200 athletes registered.

We have been back in action for two weeks following the Christmas-New Year break. Unfortunately, we found it necessary to postpone competition last Friday due to poor air quality. As is normally the case at this time of year numbers are down but we are confident they will pick up as people return from holidays and school resumes.

Our track has suffered terribly due to the lack of rain. Virtually all the grass has died. It will be interesting to see how it fairs after the recent rain.

Our congratulations go to the Albion Centre on a wonderful Zone Championships. Kiama had some good results at Zone which lead to 27 athletes qualifying for the Region 4 Championships at Lake Illawarra in early February. We have elected not to run competition on Friday 31st January so we can assist with preparations at Myimbarr Community Park for the Region 4 Championships.
