Kiama

The persistent wet weather continues to play havoc with the Athletics track at the Kiama Sports Complex. The southern end is very soft and is of particular concern. Local schools had hoped to conduct several middle-distance events last Thursday, but the track was not suitable for use, so these events were cancelled. Sadly, the Tongarra District Athletics Carnival, scheduled for Monday 8th August, has also been moved to another venue due to concerns that the track would not be capable of supporting this carnival. Consequently, we have the unprecedented situation where the Kiama Sports Complex has been unable to host a single school related athletics event in this calendar year.

The Long Jump run-ups are still covered in mould and moss. They are very slippery and will need to be cleaned prior to use which will be a challenging task. The prolonged wet has also resulted in several large trees adjacent to the Long Jump area developing a significant lean. Council have been informed and will no doubt make the area safe once conditions allow machinery access.

To add insult to injury our storage area, under the grandstand, has been flooded with up to 100mm of water on three (3) separate occasions this year.

Due to the extended football season the Kiama Little Athletics season will commence two (2) weeks later than normal on Saturday 24th September. We are genuinely concerned that the track may not be suitable for use by then if the predicted rain falls. Unfortunately, only time will tell.

Le Tape has been cancelled again due to the damage done to Jamberoo Mountain Road by recent rain. This resolves the concern we had in relation to local sporting grounds, including Kiama Sports Complex, being used as overflow car parks the week prior to the Zone Championships.
